The flowers, herbs, and pick your own crops are available to members for their own use. Please only take what you need, and can use for your family in one week. If you would like excess amounts of any item please discuss this with the Garden Manager, and we will make every effort to accommodate your request.

Please keep in mind also that farming in New England is unpredictable at best. Poor weather conditions, pests, a low producing crop, as well as many other factors can affect the actual size of the harvest. We make every effort to mitigate risks through crop diversity, multiple field selection, and use only the best quality seeds and plants. Members need to be aware however; that some items may be later than predicted and/or quantities may be limited. In the event of a low producing crop we may need to limit selection, so all members can enjoy some of the harvest. All payment is nonrefundable. Read the online updates. Each month we will have important information about food safety specific to what will be at the Farm Stand, so be sure to read and follow care instructions.

We have made every effort to make sure that all our production and food handling practices are of the highest quality. Food is picked the same day it is available. Even with all of our efforts there will be some risk associated with handling food. You can minimize that risk by following a few important tips.

- Always wash hands before handling any food. A hand sanitation station will be located at the Farm Stand and we ask that you use it before collecting your food.
- Wash your shopping bag regularly to prevent cross contamination.
- If you visit the animals during your pick up do so before getting food so the food does not sit in a hot car, or remember to bring a cooler to put the food in while you are visiting.
- Always wash everything just before eating. Do not eat unwashed food in the gardens. It may be tempting to try a fresh pea or bean from the pick your own area, but better to wash it first. Some items need to be washed before refrigerating, some should not be. Please consult care directions in your newsletter, and at the Farm Stand.
- Handle the food as little as possible. Everyone wants to touch items to make sure they are fresh and not bruised, but this the main cause of spoilage and spreads bacteria.
